KLCIS is providing safety grants to benefit our members and stretch your safety dollars.

KLCIS established the safety grant program to help you reduce workers' compensation losses and improve employee safety.



Grant Facts

Eligibility: The city or agency must be a current member of the Kentucky League of Cities Insurance Services (KLCIS) with Liability or Workers' Compensation insurance for policy year 2008-09.

Grants may not exceed \$3,000 per eligible applicant. We will only accept one (1) application per city or agency and will require a signature by the mayor or agency director. The grant application period will be January 1 through February 15, 2009 on the KLC website.

KLCIS Safety Grants will provide up to 50% of the cost of the eligible items as based on the list below. *For those cities or agencies graded on the KLCIS Scorecard System, requested items will be considered with the most recent scorecard evaluation.
