

2014-2015 KLCIS Liability Safety Grant

THE SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM HAS CHANGED

The KLCIS Safety Grant Program has been changed. The grants will now be offered at two different application periods. The KLCIS Liability Grant will be offered September 15, 2014 to November 15, 2014. The KLCIS Workers' Compensation (WC) Grant will be offered in the spring of 2015. Please pay close attention to information for each safety grant.

This Grant is for the KLCIS Liability Grant members.

The 2014-2015 Liability Safety Grant can be viewed on line. It is located at www.klcis.org or www.klc.org.

Eligibility:

- The applying city or agency must be a current member of the Kentucky League of Cities Insurance Services (KLCIS) program with General Liability or Law Enforcement insurance coverage.
- **Only one application will be accepted from each insured member.**

Important Safety Grant Program Dates:

- Application period: September 15, 2014 – November 15, 2014.
- Invoices or purchase orders must be attached to grant and returned at the same time.
- We will accept purchase orders and invoices dated July 1, 2014 to November 15, 2014.
- **Grants will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.**
- Due to the popularity of this grant there is a good chance requests will exceed available funds.

Application Rules:

- **The Safety Grant is a 50/50 matching Grant.**
- Liability:
 - Members with General Liability, Law Enforcement and/or Property coverage with total premiums less than \$35,000 are eligible for up to \$1,500 grant reimbursements for approved purchases.
 - Members with General Liability, Law Enforcement and/or Property coverage with total premiums \$35,000 and above are eligible for up to \$3,000 grant reimbursements for approved purchases.
- **We are now targeting the losses that occur most within our program. These categories will change from year to year.**
- **Only items listed below will be accepted for this grant period. No exceptions!**

Eligible Items List

Vehicles

- Interior back-up cameras, sensors and installation (not exterior back-up alarms)
- Defensive driver training

Law Enforcement (Must have KLCIS Law Enforcement Coverage)

- Police accreditation fees (Will accept fees paid during 2014)

Parks/Playgrounds

- Crumb rubber, engineered wood fiber, or pea gravel for playground cushioning material
- New playground equipment to replace old equipment

Slip and Fall Protection

- Sidewalk replacement

Sewer Backup Prevention (Must have sewer backup coverage with KLCIS)

- Cameras, rodding and hydro-blasting equipment

All grants are dependent on the availability of funds.
