# **Daytime**

Those participating in firearms qualifications will adhere to the universal firearms safety policies and procedures and follow the rules and regulations of the range while complying with orders and instructions of the Range Safety Officer at all times.

### (Warm-Up & Refresher Training) LOAD 2 MAGAZINES 7 – 7

#### **Eye and Ear Protection in Place:**

### • 7 Yard Line

- Static Shooting Draw and fire 4 rounds. (Scan & Reholster)
- Static Shooting Draw and fire 3 rounds, (RELOAD) and fire 4 rounds.
  (Scan & Reholster)
- o Static Shooting Draw and fire 3 rounds. (Scan & Reholster)

## Prepare for a Safety Check

(Qualification) LOAD 3 MAGAZINES 12 – 12 – 12

#### STAGE 1 Eye and Ear Protection in Place:

#### 3 Yard Line

- Positioned in an Interview Stance (simulating speaking with a suspect), when the threat appears, officer draws their firearm, verbalizes and engages the threat with 2 rounds as they are stepping back and moving laterally away from the threat. (3 Seconds) Scan & Reholster. You will repeat this course of fire 2 additional times.
  - (3) Courses of Fire 6 Rounds Total
  - 3 Seconds per Course of Fire

#### STAGE 2

#### • 5 Yard Line

- o Interview Stance: When the threat appears, officer draws their weapon, verbalizes, moves laterally to their RIGHT and engages the threat with 3 rounds **Strong Hand Only.** (4 Seconds) Scan & Reholster.
- o Interview Stance: When the threat appears, officer draws their weapon, verbalizes, moves laterally to their LEFT and engages the threat with 3 rounds **Strong Hand Only.** (4 Seconds) RELOAD & Scan.
- With the weapon still out, transfer to Support Hand. When the threat appears, officer will verbalize, move laterally to their RIGHT and engages the threat with 3 rounds Support Hand Only. (4 Seconds) Scan
- Keep weapon in support hand. When the threat appears, officer will verbalize, move laterally to their LEFT and engage the threat with 3 rounds Support Hand Only. (4 Seconds) Scan & Reholster.
  - (4) Courses of Fire 12 Rounds Total
  - 4 Seconds per Course of Fire

#### STAGE 3

#### • 7 Yard Line

- Interview Stance: When the threat appears, officer draws their weapon, verbalizes, moves laterally to their RIGHT and engages the threat with 4 rounds. (5 Seconds) Scan & Reholster.
- Interview Stance: When the threat appears, officer draws their weapon, verbalizes, moves laterally to their LEFT and engages the threat with 2 rounds –RELOADS--and re-engages with an additional 2 rounds.
  (12 seconds) Scan & Reholster.
  - (2) Courses of Fire 8 Rounds Total
  - 1st Course 5 Seconds / 2nd Course 12 Seconds

#### **STAGE 4**

- <u>15 Yard Line</u> (Barricade for Cover)
  - o Interview Stance: When the threat appears, officer draws weapon, verbalizes, moves **RIGHT** to a kneeling position behind cover and engages the threat with 5 Rounds. (10 Seconds) Scan & Reholster.
  - o Interview Stance: When the threat appears, officer draws weapon, verbalizes, moves **LEFT** to a kneeling position behind cover and engages the threat with 5 Rounds. (10 seconds) Scan & Reholster.
    - (2) Courses of Fire 10 Rounds Total
    - 10 Seconds per Course of Fire
