- Identify percentapoled Rethway NIGHT


 Develop comprehensive plans for proposed Pathway: implementation plan, budget cost for implementation

2. Ensure community actions support the Greenway


Find ways to connect decisions and actions to growing the trail – *Consistency and Persistence*

Funded by Grants, Governments, Businesses, Individuals Professional Staffing

Pros:

Independence Having person/s whose sole job is to make the Greenway a reality

Cons: Time and Cost to start up Funding







Develop Greenway Plans

Optimal Phasing Determined By:

- Community input
- Obstacles to surmount
- Largest impact
- Likely funding sources

Design plans for phases

Develop concurrent associated plans

- Economic Development
- Education
- Art

Repeat as needed until complete
