

KLCIS Firearms Qualification

Patrol Rifle

Those participating in firearms qualifications will adhere to the universal firearms safety policies and procedures and follow the rules and regulations of the range while complying with orders and instructions of the Range Safety Officer at all times.

(Warm-Up & Refresher Training) LOAD 2 MAGAZINES 5 – 5

Eye and Ear Protection in Place:

- **25 Yard Line**
 - Static Shooting – Fire 5 rounds from a Kneeling Position.(Reload & Scan)
 - Static Shooting – Fire 5 rounds from a Prone Position.(Scan)

Prepare for a Safety Check

(Qualification) LOAD 3 MAGAZINES 20 – 15 – 10

STAGE 1 Eye and Ear Protection in Place:

- **50 Yard Line**

(Reminder, selector switches should not be placed on fire until positioned at firing line.)

- When the threat appears, officer remains at the **50 Yard Line** and drops to a Prone Position and engages the threat with 5 rounds. (25 Seconds)
- When the threat appears, officer runs to the **40 Yard Line**, verbalizes and engages the threat with 5 rounds from a Sitting Position and 5 rounds from a Prone Position. (35 Seconds) Scan and reset back to the 50 Yard Line.
- When the threat appears, officer runs to the **25 Yard Line**, verbalizes and engages the threat with 5 rounds standing, (RELOADS) and re-engages with 5 rounds kneeling. (45 Seconds)
Scan and remain at the 25 Yard Line.
 - (3) Courses of Fire – 25 Rounds Total
 - 1st Course – 25 Seconds / 2nd Course – 35 Seconds /3rd Course – 45 Seconds

STAGE 2

- **25 Yard Line**

- When the threat appears, officer runs to the **15 Yard Line** verbalizes and engages the threat with 5 rounds from a Standing Position. (20 Seconds) Scan and remain at the 15 Yard Line.
 - (1) Courses of Fire – 5 Rounds Total
 - 20 Seconds for Course of Fire

STAGE 3

- **15 to 7 Yard Line**

- Upon receiving the command of MOVE, officer will move forward tactically to the 7 yard line. When the threat appears, officer will verbalize and engage the threat with 3 rounds. (4 Seconds) Scan and reset back to the 15 Yard Line.
- Upon receiving the command of MOVE, officer will move forward tactically to the 7 yard line. When the threat appears, officer will verbalize and engage the threat with 2 rounds, **RELOAD** and engage the threat with 1 round to the head. (10 Seconds) Scan and reset back to the 10 Yard Line.
 - (2) Courses of Fire – 6 Rounds Total
 - 1st Course – 4 Seconds / 2nd Course 10 Seconds

STAGE 4

- **10 Yard Line**

- Upon receiving the command of MOVE, officer will move forward tactically engaging the threat as it appears with 3 rounds on the move. **DO NOT PASS the 5 Yard Line.** Repeat two additional times.
 - (3) Courses of Fire – 9 Rounds Total
 - 4 Seconds per Course of Fire
