



Strains

1. Police Officer was building a catwalk at their training facility and strained his shoulder when lifting a board.
2. During a forcible entry into a residence, Police Officer kicked a door which caused a knee strain.

Strains resulting from vehicle accidents

1. Front of cruiser struck by suspect's vehicle while in pursuit, injury to neck and back.

Falls

1. (5) Police Officers slipped on ice causing them to fall which resulted in various injuries.
2. While walking to patrol vehicle, Police Officer tripped on a curb causing multiple injuries.

Exposures

1. During a call for service, Police Officer was exposed to blood on his left hand.
2. While making an arrest, Police Officer inhaled meth fumes.
3. While serving EPO papers, Police Officer was bitten on the finger by a K-9.

Arrests

1. While attempting to subdue a subject, Police Officer received a laceration to his knee.
2. While arresting a subject, Police Officer received injuries to his knee and hands.
3. While handcuffing a subject, Police Officer injured left hand.

Training

1. While exercising at the Training Academy, Police Officer strained groin and abdomen.
2. While at the Training Academy, Police Officer fell on his shoulder resulting in injury.
