



Strains

1. Police Officer strained his elbow while pulling himself up into an attic.

Falls

Cuts

Exposures

Arrests

1. Police Officer injured his hand during an arrest while struggling with a suspect who fled on foot.
2. During an arrest, suspect became combative and caused (2) officers injuries. One officer was bitten by the suspect in the hand while the other officer injured his hand and chipped his tooth.
3. Police Officer was bitten on his right arm by a suspect resisting arrest.
4. A suspect resisted arrest and the officer received a laceration to lower forearm.
5. While subduing a suspect, officer was bitten on the hand by a canine.

Training

1. While running for physical training, Police Officer experienced pain to the back of his foot.
2. While training, officer dove out of his vehicle and injured his right knee.
