



LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING AND EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

The Kentucky League of Cities (KLC) and the Kentucky Association of Counties (KACo) have partnered with The Department of Criminal Justice Training (DOCJT) to develop a series of eight-hour Kentucky Law Enforcement Council (KLEC) certified emergency driving classes. These classes satisfy requirements for HB 298 (Jill's Law), which requires all law enforcement in Kentucky to complete at least four hours of emergency driving training every two years. ■ HB298 Vehicle Operation: Reducing Operational Risk

This class is designed to meet the requirements of House Bill 298 (Jill's Law). It will address the mandatory requirements for Kentucky law enforcement agencies and officers regarding emergency and pursuit driving. The course will address agency policy, emergency and pursuit operations, legal aspects and case law, and the decision-making process for the individual officer in emergency vehicle operations. The student will also participate in driving courses for 3.5 hours at the conclusion of the classroom presentation. The course will conclude with a written test.
