

Strains

1. A police officer using a sledgehammer to force entry into a place of business strained his shoulder.

Strains from Motor Vehicle Collisions

1. A vehicle struck a police officer, causing pain to her hip and lower back.
2. A police officer received multiple injuries when his vehicle slipped on black ice, causing a collision.

Slips / Falls

1. A police officer tripped over a break in the pavement while walking on a sidewalk late at night. He fell, cutting his hand and forearm.

3. A police officer responding to a call slipped on ice, causing pain to his leg.

Slips / Falls from Foot Pursuits

1. A police officer chasing an individual in a field stepped in a hole, causing him to fall and twist his ankle.

Cuts:

1. A police officer cut his hand when it became lodged between the arm of his chair and his desk.

Exposures:

Animal & Human Bites

1. A K-9 bit a police officer's thumb.
2. A dog bit a police officer's calf when he responded to a vicious K-9 call.

Bodily Fluids

1. A police officer experienced a burning sensation and swelling in both eyes when taking an individual who had an open wound into custody.
2. A police officer was assisting EMS personnel transport an individual to the hospital when the individual spat into the officer's face.

Arrests

1. An individual began to resist being taken into custody, and multiple officers were required to restrain the individual because of his size and aggression level. He began to resist again as officers were placing the individual into the back of the police cruiser. An officer attempted to perform a knee strike on the individual but missed, striking his knee against the cruiser.
2. An individual tensed up as an officer was placing him into the back of the officer's cruiser, causing the officer to strain his thumb as he pushed the individual into the cruiser.
3. A police officer responding to a fight in progress injured their hand upon taking one of the individuals to the ground.
4. A police officer was attempting to place an individual into custody when the man grabbed the officer, slamming her onto concrete and a metal grate. The officer suffered lower back pain and scrapes to both knees.
5. A police officer attempting to restrain an individual scraped both of his knees and received lower back pain.

Training

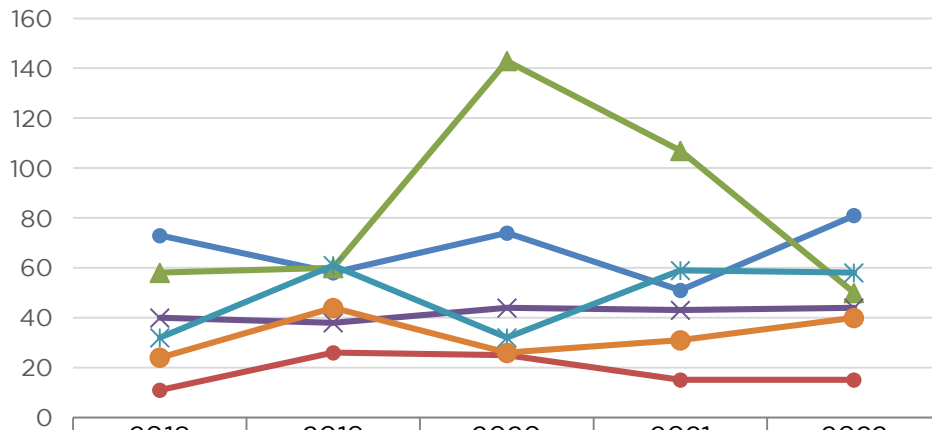
1. A police officer running sprints for physical training strained his hamstring.
