Cities often struggle with addressing how to manage vacant properties. Learn some tools available to your city to encourage property owners to act on vacant properties, including an overview of Kentucky's conservatorship statute.

When can cities demolish dangerously dilapidated properties through the code enforcement board and when must the city proceed through the court in a formal condemnation process? These common questions will be addressed as participants gain knowledge on how to manage the demolition process consistent with state and federal law.
