## WELCOME!

Dear KLC Insurance Members and Friends:

Due to the continued threat and uncertainty surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, the Risk & Safety Conference Advisory Board and KLC has made the difficult decision to go to an online virtual format for the 2021 Risk & Safety Conference. As you recall, precautionary safety measures were immediately implemented and the 2020 conference was cut short because of the news that a highly contagious virus was spreading across Kentucky. It was our hope that we could meet in person for the 2021 conference, but we want to be cautious until the risk of the virus has subsided.

We wanted to have a viable option for those who rely on this conference for risk and safety training. It will obviously not be the same without the opportunity to meet old friends and network with the new faces we see attending each year. Not to mention, catching up with friends during the evening activities.

The 2021 conference will be held virtually this year during the same three days as originally scheduled, March 10-12. We will be offering online training from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. each day. For those seeking drinking water and wastewater continuing education credits, four hours of the training will qualify. In order to receive this credit, each person must register for the conference and be present for the entirety of the sessions. Attendance will be monitored to verify the courses were completed prior to submitting documentation to the Kentucky Division of Water.

Because expenses will be significantly decreased using this format, we reduced the registration to \$50 for members and \$100 for nonmembers. One day registrations are \$25 for members and \$50 for nonmembers. Registration costs will remain eligible for reimbursement through the KLC Safety Grant for KLC insurance members only.

Again, we regret that we must go to this format, but we firmly believe it to be the best way to keep our conference patrons, their coworkers and families safe and healthy.
