



LIABILITY GRANT PROGRAM

Eligibility

- ♦ The applying city or agency must be a current member of KLC Insurance Services (KLCIS) with liability coverage.
- ♦ Only one application will be accepted from each insured member.

See klc.org for application dates and deadlines.

- ♦ Invoices or purchase orders must be attached to the application and returned at the same time.
- ♦ We advise members to apply early.
- ♦ If liability grant applications exceed funds available, grants will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ♦ All applications must be submitted online.

The Liability Grant is a 50/50 matching grant for approved purchases.

- ♦ Members with liability premiums before taxes less than \$35,000 are eligible for up to \$1,500 grant reimbursements.
- ♦ Members with liability premiums before taxes of \$35,000 and above are eligible for up to \$3,000 grant reimbursements.

ELIGIBLE ITEMS



■ Vehicles

- ◆ Defensive driver training
- ◆ Telematic systems that are used to enforce fleet safety and influence safe driving behaviors
- ◆ Costs associated with conducting pre-hire or annual motor vehicle record (MVR) checks
- ◆ Backup cameras and sensors

■ Personnel Services

- ◆ Employee handbooks and training provided by the KLC legal team invoiced during the calendar year

■ Mowers

- ◆ Mulching mowers or kits to prevent discharge accidents

■ Law Enforcement

- (must have KLCIS law enforcement coverage)
- ◆ Police accreditation fees paid during the calendar year
- ◆ Defensive driver training and telematic systems
- ◆ Body cameras (storage and monthly fees are not included, and model policy must be submitted with the application)
- ◆ Gun safes

■ Parks/Playgrounds

- ◆ Any fall protection listed under the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) Guidelines
- ◆ New playground equipment to replace old equipment (picture required of old or damaged equipment)

■ Slip and Fall Protection

- ◆ Sidewalk replacement or repair

■ Utilities

- ◆ Sewer backup prevention (must have sewer backup coverage with KLCIS)
- ◆ Cameras, rodding, and hydro blasting equipment
- ◆ Radio read meters (gas and water)
- ◆ Meter lids that meet liability review guidelines for KLCIS
- ◆ Hit kits for natural gas companies to document damaged lines (example Rhino Hit Kit)
- ◆ Signage for electric utilities (e.g., high voltage, no trespassing)
- ◆ Trimming trees around electrical substations, utility perimeter fencing and electrical transmission right-of-ways

■ Cybersecurity

- ◆ Threat assessment (costs associated with conducting on-site threat or vulnerability assessment)
- ◆ Training costs related to cybersecurity
- ◆ Costs associated with Advanced Threat Protection Add-On if using Microsoft Office 365
- ◆ Multifactor authentication – cost for support of initial set up
